



Adela Popowicz

March 3, 1928 - April 5, 2010

Mrs. Adela (Plaskota) Popowicz, 82, of 36 Lorraine Drive, North Adams, died on Monday, April 5, 2010, at Williamstown Commons.

She was born in Poland on March 3, 1928, a daughter of the late Michael and Maryann (Michalak) Plaskota. She attended schools in Poland and moved to the United States in 1962.
