



## Albert Joseph Stavaski

February 10, 1938 - April 26, 2007

Mr. Albert Joseph Stavaski, 69, of 2 Fryc Lane, Adams, died Thursday morning at his daughter's home in Canaan, New Hampshire following a long illness.

He was born in Adams on February 10, 1938, a son of the late John J. and Ellen M. (Weaver) Stavaski. He attended Adams schools, graduating with honors from the former Adams High School in 1956. He obtained a Bachelor's degree in Management from North Adams State College in 1976.

Mr. Stavaski went to work at General Electric Co. in Pittsfield in 1956, and while there, took many courses on manufacturing, management and toolmaking. He also graduated from Western New England College in Springfield in 1963 with a certificate in Mechanical Engineering. He retired from GE in 1993 as a Senior Quality Specialist/Engineer after 38 years of service.

Mr. Stavaski was a former member of the Adams Zoning Board of Appeals, and served as its chairman for several years. He was also a licensed real estate agent.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. He was a member of the General Electric Quarter Century and Pensioner's Clubs and the National Rifle Association.

He enjoyed woodworking, hunting and fishing, and was an accomplished photographer, winning prizes for many of his photographs in competitions. He is survived by his wife of 46 years, the former Virginia Duda, whom he

married on October 15, 1960;
