Mr. Albin "Abu" Joseph Krzeminski, 88, of Adams, died on Monday, November 24, 2014 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on January 25, 1926, a son of the late Leo and Helen (Michalski) Krzeminski. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School.

Mr. Krzeminski was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict, having served with the United States Army until receiving his Honorable Discharge on March 9, 1954.

Mr. Krzeminski worked for many years in the maintenance department of General Electric Co., Pittsfield until his retirement.

He was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II at St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. His wife, the former Cyrilla McKenna, whom he married on September 10, 1955, died on April 28, 2013.

He was predeceased by his brother, Emil Krzeminski.
