Alfred Eugene "Dewey" Malloy, 65, formerly of Cheshire and Adams, died Monday, January 5th, at the O.S.U. Hospital in Columbus, Ohio.

He was born in Adams on January 25, 1943, a son of the late James and Rita (Cross) Malloy, and attended Cheshire schools. As a young man, he worked on the family farm, and worked with his father and brothers logging and pulping. He later worked for the Adams Department of Public Works and the Adams Water Department. He was also a former member of the Alert Hose Company.

In the early 1980's, he and his family moved to Columbus, where he had worked for the SCOA, Limited and Atlas companies.

He enjoyed fishing, hunting, camping, riding motorcycles and repairing vehicles.
