Mr. Allan H. Goodrich, Sr., 88, of 50 Farview Heights, Clarksburg, died on Friday, November 1, 2013, at Mt. Greylock Extended Care Facility in Pittsfield. He was born in North Adams on February 25, 1925, a son of the late Howard and Annie (Hewitt) Goodrich. He attended schools in North Adams.

Mr. Goodrich was a Veteran of World War II having served with the United States Marine Corps from March 17, 1942 until receiving his Honorable Discharge on March 22, 1946.

Mr. Goodrich worked for many years as a machine operator for the former James Hunter Machine Co., North Adams and the former Beloit Co., Adams. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of North Adams. He was a longtime member and past Master and district deputy grand master of the Berkshire Lodge of Masons. He was also a founding member of the Clarksburg Veterans of Foreign Wars.

His wife, the former Muriel Blanchard, whom he married on April 27, 1946, died on March 29, 2007.
