



Mr. Lawrence A. Luczynski

November 21, 1936 - February 25, 2014

Mr. Lawrence A. Luczynski, 77, of Main Rd. Savoy, died Tuesday afternoon, February 25th, 2014, at his home.

He was born in Adams on November 21, 1936, a son of the late Matthew and Frances (Waryjasz) Luczynski, and attended schools in Savoy and Adams.

Mr. Luczynski was a heavy equipment operator most all of his life. He last worked for the former D. Krutiak Construction Co. for 10 years. Earlier, he had worked for Puffer Construction Co., Mackin Construction Co., and B & M Construction Co. As a young man, he worked with his father at several sawmill operations in Savoy, and also assisted him in the operation of the former Matt's Lodge in Savoy.

He was a member of the Operating Engineer's Union Local 98, and was a member of the National Rifle Association.

He enjoyed hunting and fishing, beekeeping, mushrooming, watching boxing matches, and was famous for his hard cider he made from scratch and the clambakes he hosted. He especially enjoyed spending time with his grandsons, telling them many stories of growing up and working hard in the "old days".

His wife, the former Laurette A. Boucher, whom he married on November 28, 1958, died on April 3, 2007.

He is survived by 2 sons, Timothy Luczynski and his wife, Karen, of Cheshire; and James Luczynski and his companion, Susan, of Hinsdale;

2 grandsons, Mathew and Nathan Luczynski; his Granddog, Buddy, and

several nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by 2 brothers, Frank Luczynski and Richard "Butch" Luczynski.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, March 1st, at 11:00 AM in the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams. Deacon Gregory LaFreniere, of the Parish of Blessed John Paul, Adams, will officiate.

Burial will follow in Southview Cemetery, North Adams.
