Mrs. Angelina Mary "Angie" (Burzimati) Poulton, 71, of 3 Third Ave. Cheshire, died Thursday morning, October 16, 2014, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

She was born in Pittsfield on April 18, 1943, a daughter of the late Fioravanti "John" Burzimati and Lena (Sondrini) Burzimati. She attended schools in Cheshire and Adams, graduating from the former Adams High School. She then graduated from the former LeBarron's School of Hairdressing in Pittsfield.
