



## Mrs. Anna V. Clermont

December 18, 1918 - October 24, 2015

Mrs. Anna Victoria (Kozak) Clermont, 96, formerly of 17 Pleasant St. Adams, died early Saturday morning, October 24, 2015, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Philadelphia, PA on December 18, 1918, a daughter of the late Ludwik and Victoria (Czech) Kozak. She came to this area as a child with her family, and attended local schools.
