



## Anne M. Mastroianni

February 16, 1936 - February 1, 2008

Anne Marie (Provencher) Mastroianni, 71, of 6 Simon Ave. Adams, a longtime local educator and guidance counselor, died Friday morning, February 1, 2008, at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown, following a brief battle with cancer.

She was born in North Adams on February 16, 1936, daughter of the late Frank and Anna (Dion) Provencher, the original proprietors of Berkshire Optical Co. in North Adams. She attended North Adams schools, including the former Notre Dame Elementary School, and graduated from Drury High School. She attended the former North Adams State College, now MCLA, where she earned her Bachelor's degree in Education and her Master's degree in Education and Guidance.

She first taught in the Greenfield school system for several years, and then began her career at Drury High School in North Adams, first as a teacher, and then as a guidance counselor, until retiring in 1996 after over 30 years of service.

She was member of the North Adams Teacher's Association, the Massachusetts Teacher's Association, the New England Teachers Association, and the Berkshire County Guidance Association.

She is survived by 2 Sons - Scott Mastroianni and Eric Mastroianni, both of Berlin, MA;

2 Sisters - Joan Sindermann and her husband, Carl, of Easton, Maryland; and Cecile Schneider and her husband, Harold, of Merrimack, New Hampshire;

1 Brother - Alfred Provencher and his wife, Jean, of West Long Branch, New Jersey;

Her former husband - Leo Mastroianni of North Adams, and several nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews.

She was predeceased by a sister, Claire Dean, and a brother, Frank Provencher.

The funeral will be held on Wednesday, February 6, at 10:30 AM in the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams.

Rev. Daniel J. Boyle, Pastor of the Catholic Parishes of Adams, will officiate.

Burial will be at a later date.

Calling hours are Tuesday, February 5th, from 4 to 7 PM at the funeral home.
