September 1, 1920 - February 4, 2006

Mr. Anthony Vigna, 85, of 14 Haggerty St. Adams, died early Saturday morning, February 4, 2006, at Albany (NY) Medical Center.

He was born in North Adams on September 1, 1920, a son of the late Frank and Carolina (Gaglianese) Vigna, and attended North Adams schools.
