Mrs. Antonietta "Toni" (Nolfo) Mazzantini, 92, of Adams, died Sunday morning, September 11, 2022 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. She was born in Castellammare del Golfo, Sicily on February 2, 1930, a daughter of the late Ludovico and Caterina (D'Aguana) Nolfo. She attended schools in Sicily and came here in 1951.

Toni last worked as a seamstress for the former CB Sports until her retirement. Earlier, she had worked at the former Hunter Outdoor Products and Sprague Electric Co. She was a communicant of St. John Paul II Parish at the former St. Thomas Aquinas Church, Adams, and was a member of its Rosary Sodality. She was a member of Court Sancta Regina, Catholic Daughters of the Americas, the Sons of Italy and the ITAM Lodge, Pittsfield. She was also an active member of the St. John Paul Adoration Chapel. She enjoyed sewing and knitting, was a fabulous cook and especially enjoyed entertaining family and friends.
