Mrs. Arlene Isabella (Coody) Estes, 78, of 194 Central St., Gardner, formerly of 43 Mohawk Forrest, North Adams, died early Saturday morning, July 24, 2010, at the Wachusett Manor Nursing Home, Gardner.
