Mr. Armand Adrien "Mike" Clermont, 92, of 17 Pleasant St. Adams, died Saturday evening at North Adams Commons.

He was born in Adams on October 28, 1914, a son of the late Henri and Alexina (Rancourt) Clermont, and attended Adams schools.

Mr. Clermont worked for the Boston & Maine Railroad for several years, until retiring 30 years ago. Earlier, he had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams.
