



Arthur N. Bond

May 21, 1926 - June 16, 2010

Mr. Arthur Newton "Newt" Bond, 84, of 8 Crandall St., Adams, died early Wednesday morning, June 16, 2010 at Williamstown Commons.

He was born in Adams on May 21, 1926, a son of the late Nelson and Marion (Alderman) Bond. He attended schools in Adams and had also attended the former Bliss Business School, North Adams.

Mr. Bond was a Veteran of World War II, having served with the United States Navy from May 18, 1944 until receiving his Honorable Discharge as Fire Controlman Third Class on June 9, 1946.

Mr. Bond worked for several years for the Adams Waste Water Treatment Plant until his retirement. He had also worked for the former Arnold Fuel Co., Adams.

Mr. Bond was a longtime Adams firefighter, serving with the Alert Hose Co. from 1950 until retiring as an Honorary Member in 1973.

He was a former member of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. As a young man Newt was one of the first people to ski the Thunderbolt Ski Trail on the face of Mt. Greylock in Adams.

His wife, the former Celia Stawarz, whom he married on August 19, 1950, died on April 26, 1994.
