Barbara Frances Couture, 76, of Adams, passed away on Friday, October 28, 2022, at her home.

She was born in Adams on March 23, 1946, a daughter of the late Francis and Ann (Chwalek) Couture. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former St. Joseph's High School in North Adams with the class of 1964. She then went on to earn her Bachelor's in Mathematics and Master of Education from the former North Adams State College.

Barbara taught middle school mathematics for 35 years in the Adams Cheshire Regional School District until her retirement.

She was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II, Adams.

She is survived by her sister, Regina Hill and her husband Richard of Adams; her sister-in-law, Joan Couture of Adams; seven nieces and nephews, including, Heather Couture-Cantine, Jay and Erin Couture, Kristen Lucas, Jarrid Couture, Alexandra Hill-Paduano and Ian Hill; 4 great nieces, 1 great nephew, and her longtime friend Joseph Lentine of Adams.
