Mrs. Barbara J. (Kreiger) Scott, 84, of Dalton, died on Saturday, August 24, 2019 at the Mt. Greylock Extended Care Facility in Pittsfield.

She was born in Pittsfield on May 12, 1935, daughter of the late Albert and Gertrude (Zahn) Kreiger. She attended schools in Pittsfield and graduated from Pittsfield High School.

She was a veteran of the Vietnam War, having served with the United States Marine Corps until receiving her Honorable Discharge as Private First Class on February 10, 1956.

Barb was primarily a homemaker but had worked for the former Duff & Dell's Variety in Dalton.

She was a member of the First Congregational Church of Dalton where she enjoyed singing in the choir. She was a life member, past president and past director of the Pittsfield Sportsman's Club, past president of the Dalton Lions Club, member of the Dalton American Legion and an active member of the Dalton Senior Center. She was an avid cross stitcher, enjoyed quilting, cooking and baking.

Her husband Ronald R. Scott, whom she married on November 26, 1955, died on September 19, 2006.
