Mr. Barry Alan Kittler, 48, of 155 Devonshire Dr., Cheshire, died on Wednesday, October 1, 2014 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. He was born in Pittsfield on February 19, 1966, a son of Alwine and Marcia (Wiencek) Kittler. He attended schools in Adams, including St. Stanislaus Kostka Elementary School and graduated from Hoosac Valley High School. He then went on to earn his Bachelor's Degree in Computer Information Sciences from the University of Massachusetts.

At the time of his death, Barry was working as a Letter Carrier at the Adams Post Office. He had also worked as a senior consultant for Keane Inc., Pittsfield.

Barry was avid fisherman and hunter and enjoyed bowling and hiking.
