Mrs. Beatrice Marguerite (Langlois) Wood, 85, of 2407 Sagarmal Court, Dunn Loring, Virginia, formerly of 51 Melrose St. Adams, died Thursday, April 19, 2007 at her residence.

She was born in Adams on January 20, 1922, a daughter of the late Elie and Blanche (Brodeur) Langlois, and attended Adams schools, graduating from the former Adams High School in 1940. She had lived in Adams until moving to Virginia to live with her son in 2006.
