February 13, 1924 - June 1, 2006

Benjamin Peter Warchol, 82, of 4 East Orchard Terrace, Adams, died Thursday evening, June 1, 2006, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. He was born in Adams on February 13, 1924, a son of the late Peter and Mary (Szpila) Warchol, and Attended Adams schools. He graduated from the former Adams High School, where he was active in sports.

Mr. Warchol was a US Army Veteran of World War II, serving with Company B of the 156th Infantry Regiment in the European Theater.

Mr. Warchol worked in the Power Transformer division of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield for over 30 years until retiring in 1989.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, and a member of the St. Stanislaus Kostka Society. He was an avid golfer and bowler, and was a member of Forest Park Country Club and the East Hoosac AA Bowling League.

He is survived by his wife, the former Stella I. Nowak, whom he married on February 7, 1953;
