



Bernard T. Beauchemin

Mr. Bernard "Bernie" Theophile Beauchemin, 83, of 1 Cedar Lane, Adams, died on Monday April 14, 2008, at Berkshire Medical Center, Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on December 31, 1924, a son of the late Albert and Albertine (Brodeur) Beauchemin. He attended Adams schools.
