Mr. Bernard Arthur "Bernie" Rolland, 83, of 25 Pleasant St. Adams, died Saturday evening, Sept. 10, 2011, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. He was born in Adams on April 27, 1928, a son of the late Alfred and Eva (Herzog) Rolland, and attended Adams schools.
