Mr. Bernerd Lewis Dennis, 94, of 1561 Cold Spring Road, Williamstown, formerly of 3 Myrtle St., Adams, died on Tuesday, November 29, 2011 at Sweet Brook Care Center. He had also lived in Sandwich, MA for 25 years. He was born in Williamstown on April 5, 1917, a son of the late Fred and Bessie (Van Horn) Dennis. He graduated from Drury High School in 1936.
