Mrs. Bernice Dorothy (St. Onge) Anderson, 87, of 1 Hathaway St., Adams, died on Friday, June 19, 2015 at Sweet Brook Care Center in Williamstown.

She was born in Detroit, Michigan on November 9, 1927, daughter of the late Joseph and Dorothy (Randall) St. Onge. She moved to Adams as a child and attended schools in Adams.

Her husband, George "Skiddy" Anderson, Sr., whom she married on November 30, 1946, died on March 2, 1997.
