Mrs. Betty C. (Kenney) LaRoche, 93, of Cheshire, formerly of Adams, died Friday morning, December 8, 2017, at Hillcrest Commons in Pittsfield.

She was born in Adams on September 2, 1924, a daughter of the late Henry and Mabel (Wilbur) Kenney, and attended Adams schools. She lived in Adams most of her life until moving to Cheshire several years ago.

Betty last worked as a school bus driver for Dufour, Inc., and earlier, for the former E.W. DeGere Transportation in Adams, from 1970 until retiring in 1995. Earlier, she had worked at the former Signet Corp. in Adams for several years.
