Mrs. Blanche Eleanor (Crofts) Heggie, 97, of 1561 Cold Spring Rd., Williamstown, a former longtime resident of North Adams, died on Saturday, November 9, 2013 at the North Adams Regional Hospital.

She was born in North Adams on October 26, 1916, daughter of the late Thomas and Blanche (Hicks) Crofts. She attended schools in North Adams and graduated from Drury High School with the class of 1934.

Mrs. Heggie worked as a telephone operator for the former New England Telephone & Telegraph, North Adams. She had also worked for the former James Hunter Machine Co., and the former Sprague Electric Co., both North Adams.

Mrs. Heggie was a longtime member of St. John's Episcopal Church, now All Saints Episcopal Church, North Adams, where she had served for many years on the Altar Guild. She was also a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution.

Her husband, Norman F. Heggie, Sr., whom she married on May 3, 1941, died in 1991.

She is survived by 2 Sons, Norman F. Heggie, Jr. and his wife Norma of Westfield and Thomas A. Heggie and his wife Evelyn of Bennington; 4 Grandchildren, 5 Great Grandchildren, 1 Great Great Grandchild, and many nieces and nephews.

She was predeceased by 2 brothers, Thomas and John Crofts and by 3 Sisters, Dorothy Henderson, Helen Judd and Barbara Urban.

Funeral Services will be held on Thursday, November 14 at 10:00AM in All Saints Episcopal Church, 59 Summer St., North Adams. Rev. Stephen White, Priest-in-Charge, will be celebrant.

Burial will follow in Southview Cemetery, North Adams.
