Mr. Bruno Raymond Dubis, 93, of 22 Belvedere Ter., Yarmouth Port, MA, formerly of Adams, died Wednesday July 12, 2006, at Mayflower Place Nursing Center, West Yarmouth, MA, after a battle with cancer.
