



## Bryan M. Robinson

August 10, 1966 - June 11, 2006

Bryan Michael Robinson, 39, of 8 Arnold Avenue, Adams, died Sunday morning, June 11, 2006, at Hillcrest Commons in Pittsfield following a long illness.

He was born in North Adams on August 10, 1966, a son of James A. and Cynthia A. (Rodowicz) Robinson. He attended Adams schools, and graduated from Hoosac Valley High School in 1986.
