



Casimer Milos

October 31, 1915 - February 14, 2008

Mr. Casimer "Kai" Milos, 92, of 7 Dubis St., Adams, died on Thursday February 14, 2008, at the North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in Adams on October 31, 1915, a son of the late Walenty and Maria (Kondel) Milos. He attended schools in Adams.

Mr. Milos had last worked for General Electric Co., Pittsfield until retiring in 1978. Earlier he had worked for the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard in Portsmouth, NH, and in the Jones Division of the former Arnold Print Works, Adams.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. He was a member of the Maple Grove Civic Club, Adams, and a former member of the Berkshire Camera Club. He enjoyed photography, gardening, flowers, and traveling.

He was predeceased by 3 brothers; John, William, and Matthew Milos, and by 2 sisters; Stefania Baran Melillo and Mildred Irza.

The funeral will be held on Monday February 18, at 9:00AM from the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St., Adams, followed by a Liturgy of Christian Burial at 10:00AM in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams.
