Mrs. Cecelia Lucy (Duda) Krzanik, 90, formerly of 5 Marshall Avenue, Adams, died Tuesday, February 13, 2007, at River Garden Hebrew Home in Jacksonville, Florida, where she had resided for the past four years.

She was born in North Adams on December 13, 1916, the daughter of the late Anthony and Rosalie (Obara) Duda. She attended the former St. Joseph's Elementary School and was a graduate of the former St. Joseph's High School. She moved to Adams in 1949.

Mrs. Krzanik worked at Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams for 25 years, until retiring in 1978.
