



Cecelia W. Lepak

August 12, 1912 - January 4, 2007

Mrs. Cecelia Rose (Wanat) Lepak, 94, of 56 Orchard St., Adams, died Thursday afternoon January 4, 2007, at Williamstown Commons.

She was born in Adams on August 12, 1912, daughter of the late Joseph and Aniela (Furtek) Wanat. She moved to Cheshire as a child and attended schools there, until returning to Adams in 1933.

Mrs. Lepak worked as a stitcher for 14 years for the former Wall Streeter Shoe Co., North Adams, until her retirement in 1974. Prior she had worked for the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co, Adams.

Her husband John Lepak, whom she married on November 6, 1933, died September 28, 1991.
