August 30, 1923 - July 16, 2013

Mrs. Cecile M. (Cardonnel) Bishop, 89, of 160 North Summer St. Adams, died early Tuesday morning, July 16, 2013, at Albany (NY) Medical Center.

She was born in Adams on August 30, 1923, a daughter of the late Omer and Mary (Gazaille) Cardonnel, and attended Adams schools, including the former Notre Dame School.

Mrs. Bishop was primarily a homemaker for most of her life, but had worked for several years at the former Brightwater Paper Co. and its successor, James River Paper Co. in Adams.

She was a communicant of the Parish of Blessed John Paul and its predecessor, the Parish of Notre Dame & St. Thomas Aquinas, Adams, and enjoyed playing Bingo.

Her husband, George P. Bishop, whom she married on May 25, 1946, died on October 21, 1989.
