



Mrs. Celia B. Wilk

Celia B. (Lipinski) Wilk, 91, passed away on Friday, December 6th, 2019, at Wingate Nursing Home of Sudbury where she lived the past seven months. She was born in Adams on November 16th, 1928, the daughter of the late Zigmund and Isabelle (Kozik) Lipinski. She attended Adams Schools and graduated from Adams High School with the Class of 1948. Mrs. Wilk worked for many years at the former Sprague Electric Company until the plant closed in 1985. She last worked at Berkshire Life Insurance Company in Pittsfield MA until she retired in 1993.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, where she had been part of the sit in to keep the church open. She was also a member of the St. Stanislaus Kostka Society. She enjoyed bowling, gardening, knitting, and loved listening and dancing to Polish music. She was an avid golfer and a former member of Stamford Valley Golf Course in Stamford VT. After she retired, she looked forward to spending the winter months, in Florida, with her late husband.

Her husband, Matthew F. Wilk, whom she married on July 5, 1948, died on July 12, 2004.
