Mr. Charles Joseph Bissaillon, 76, of 79 Lime St., Adams, died on Thursday, January 22, 2015 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in North Adams on May 26, 1938, son of the late Andrew and Bertha (Duguay) Bissaillon, He attended schools in Adams.

Mr. Bissaillon was a Veteran of the United States Army, having served during the Vietnam Era. He was Honorably Discharged on October 2, 1963.

Mr. Bissaillon worked as an assembler in the Power Transformer Division of General Electric Co., Pittsfield. Following his retirement he went to work as a driver for the Berkshire Community Action Council, Pittsfield. He was an avid woodworker and enjoyed gardening.

His wife, the former Judith Arigoni, whom he married in 1965, died on January 19, 1972.
