



Chester "Ali" Alibozek

Mr. Chester Francis "Ali" Alibozek, 80, of 690 Sandmill Road, Cheshire, died on Wednesday, September 24, 2014 at his home surrounded by his family. He was born in Adams on January 13, 1934, a son of the late Chester and Eleanor (Mikuszewski) Alibozek. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1951.

Mr. Alibozek was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict, having served with the United States Army 82nd Airborne Division and worked in the Pentagon as a Polish Translator until receiving his Honorable Discharge on March 31, 1955. Chester last worked as a construction superintendent for the former D. Krutiak Construction Co., Adams and previously worked for Petricca Construction. He was a proud member of the Polish American Club in South Deerfield, the Adams Post 160 American Legion, and a past member of the Maple Grove Civic Club and St. Stanislaus Kostka Society, Adams.

Remembered for his quick wit and infectious smile, Chester was extremely proud of all his grandchildren, spending much of his time sharing their successes and achievements with friends and family members, keeping his own scrapbook of newspaper clippings for reference. He was an avid sports fan of the Oakland Raiders, Detroit Tigers, the Notre Dame Fighting Irish, and LPGA golf. He played softball for teams in Adams and North Adams until his late fifties, winning many tournaments and awards for his expertise on the pitching mound.
