Mr. Clifford Russell Feakes, 77, of 1 Berkshire Square, Adams, died on Saturday, December 25, 2010, at the North Adams Regional Hospital. He was born in Rahway, New Jersey, son of the late L. Russell and Martha (Hopkins) Feakes. He attended schools in New Jersey and graduated from the Highland Park High School with the class of 1950. Mr. Feakes then graduated from Dartmouth College with the class of 1954, receiving his Bachelor's Degree in Liberal Arts with a major in Economics.

Mr. Feakes last owned and operated Townry Farm/B&B in Lanesborough, MA. Earlier in his career he was the proprietor of Town & Country Inc., a Better Womens Apparel Store in Pittsfield, MA. After graduating from Dartmouth, Mr. Feakes worked as a buyer for Mercantile Stores Co. Inc, a retail department stores group, buying for companies in Ohio, Alabama and Florida.

Mr. Feakes served on the Board of Trustees of the New Brunswick Theological Seminary, New Brunswick, NJ for 9 years. He had also served on the Endowment Advisory Committee for WMHT Telecommunications, in Schenectady, NY from 1990 until 1993. He was also been a great supporter of the Berkshire Choral Festival, Sheffield, MA.

He is survived by his wife of 39 years, the former Barbara A. Young, whom he married on December 18, 1971;
