Mrs. Cyrilla Jane Krzeminski, 80, of 10 Burt St., Adams, died on Sunday, April 28, 2013 at North Adams Commons.

She was born in Adams on October 15, 1932, a daughter of the late Ralph and Cyrilla (Cassidy) McKenna. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1950.
