



## Daniel Krzeminski

November 25, 1929 - May 24, 2007

Mr. Daniel Krzeminski, 77, of 93 Lime St., Adams, died early Thursday morning at his home.

He was born in Adams on November 25, 1929, son of the late Walter and Stacia (Gancarz) Krzeminski. He attended Adams schools, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1949.

Mr. Krzeminski was a Veteran of the Korean War, having served with the United States Army.
