May 26, 1953 - July 12, 2023

With great sadness, the family of Daniel Soha, 70, of Adams announces his passing at home on July 12th, 2023.

He was born in Adams on May 26, 1953, a son of the late Rudolph and Angela (Godek) Soha. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from Hoosac Valley High School with the class of 1971.
