



## Mrs. Danielle Trottier

June 23, 1938 - January 2, 2018

Mrs. Danielle (Huet) Trottier, 79, of Adams, died Tuesday evening, January 2, 2018, at Baystate Medical Center in Springfield.

Danielle was born in New York City on June 23, 1938, a daughter of the late Yves and Lucienne (Lessard) Huet. She grew up with her sisters Anne and Michele, and brother, Andre, in New Britain, CT.

Danielle graduated from St. Mary's School of Nursing in Waterbury, CT, as a Registered Nurse.
