



## Mr. Donald B. Beliveau, Jr.

August 12, 1967 - October 28, 2015

Mr. Donald Bernard Beliveau, Jr., 48, of 16 Summer St. Adams, died suddenly Wednesday afternoon, October 28, 2015, at Cooley-Dickinson Hospital in Northampton.

He was born in North Adams on August 12, 1967, a son of the late Donald B. and Linda A. (Martin) Beliveau. He attended schools in Adams, and graduated from Hoosac Valley High School with the Class of 1986.

Donny worked as a plumbing foreman for many years and was currently employed by Dobbert Heating and Cooling in North Adams at the time of his death.

Donny enjoyed good cigars with a glass of whiskey, cornhole toss, singing with the juke box, playing pool and hanging with his infinite number of friends at The Grille and the VFW. Donny's favorite thing was to spend time with his wife and children on family outings- going out to dinner, going to tag sales, antiquing, remodeling the house or just sitting around a fire in the backyard for the evening.

Donny is survived by his wife of 24 years, the former Martha E. Lamore, whom he married on May 25, 1991; their children, Brodie, Karlie and Tucker, all at home in Adams;
