



Donald F. Lucia

July 10, 1929 - November 5, 2009

Mr. Donald F. Lucia, 80, of 2 Beecher St., Adams, died on Thursday, November 5, 2009, at North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in Whatley, MA on July 10, 1929, a son of the late Arthur and Rena (Depelteau) Lucia. He attended schools in Adams.

Mr. Lucia was a Veteran of the Korean War, having served with the United States Army from 1951 until receiving his Honorable Discharge in 1953.

Mr. Lucia worked for the former New England Lime Co., Adams, and its successor the former Pfizer Co., Adams for 30 years until retiring in 1989. He had also worked for Val's Variety in Adams. Following his retirement he drove for the Berkshire Community Action Council, Pittsfield.

He was a communicant of the former Parish of Notre Dame & St. Thomas Aquinas, Adams.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, the former Dorothy A. Wooley, whom he married on October 31, 1953.
