



Doris D. Armstrong

February 18, 1912 - November 7, 2010

Mrs. Doris I. (Dore) Armstrong, 98, of 197 North Summer St., Adams, died early Sunday morning, November 7, 2010, at Sweet Brook Care Center, Williamstown, where she had been a resident since September 19, 2008. She was born in Moosup, Connecticut on February 18, 1912, a daughter of the late Joseph and Elizabeth (Bourque) Dore. She moved to Adams as a child with her family and attended schools there, including the former Notre Dame Elementary School, and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1929.

Mrs. Armstrong worked for many years as a bookkeeper. She had worked for the former Millette Service, Rene Comeau Trucking, Butler Wholesale and the Adams Rest Home. She had also worked for her husband's business, Armstrong Texaco from 1953 to 1982.

She was a communicant of the Parish of Pope John Paul the Great, Adams. Her husband, John H. Armstrong, Sr., whom she married on May 30, 1944, died on November 15, 1993.

She is survived by her son, John H. Armstrong, Jr. and his wife Diane of Adams;

She was predeceased by a brother, Gerard Dore and by 2 sisters, Aurore McDevitt and Rita Moore.
