Mrs. Doris T. (Ramsdell) Guillou, 97, of Chesapeake, VA, formerly of Pittsfield and Adams, died on Saturday, August 24, 2024, at her home.

She was born in Adams on February 22, 1927, a daughter of the late Charles and Elizabeth (Goodfellow) Ramsdell. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School.

Mrs. Guillou worked as an executive assistant for General Electric Co., Pittsfield for 40 years until retiring. She then worked as an executive assistant for Century 21 in Pittsfield.

She was a communicant of Sacred Heart Church, Pittsfield and had been a longtime communicant of the former St. Theresa's Church, Pittsfield.
