Mrs. Doris Dawn (Harrington) Marcil, 88, of 313 East Road, Adams, went home to Jesus and the arms of her husband and 2 beloved daughters on Wednesday afternoon, June 16, 2010, after a brief stay at Williamstown Commons.

She was born in New Bethlehem, Pennsylvania on July 14, 1921, a daughter of the late Orville and Lottie (Fitzroy) Harrington. She came to this area as a child with her family, and attended Adams schools. She lived in Adams until moving to Lady Lake, Florida in 1977. She returned to Adams in 1998.
