



Mrs. Doris B. McAndrews

April 10, 1925 - April 27, 2017

Doris B. McAndrews , daughter of Julia L. and William A. Steuer, died at her home in Naples, Fl. on April 27th 2017.

She was born April 10, 1925 in Adams , MA. Upon graduation from Adams High School, she worked as a secretary for Berkshire Textile, owned and operated by Gilmore Rudnick. When it ceased operations she became office manager of the Old Stone Mill, a nationally recognized corporation noted to be one of the last vestiges of hand-screened printed wallpaper. Doris worked there for multiple years until her retirement.

She celebrated her 92nd birthday on April 10th. Her husband, Michael F. McAndrews, former owner of Smith Bros.-McAndrews Insurance, died in 2005.

She is survived by one son, Bruce M. McAndrews of Florida and Maine, a sister Nancy Cwalinski and her husband Walter of Bonita Springs ,Fl. and many nieces and nephews.

She was predeceased by her parents and step-father Frank C. Steuer, and by two brothers William A. Steuer Jr. and Robert, who died in infancy.
