Doris Marion (Green) Morey, 93, of 45 Main St., Dalton, formerly of Adams, died on Monday, August 26, 2013 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield. She was born in North Adams on October 19, 1919, a daughter of the late William and Marion (Gauthier) Green. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1937. She also graduated from the Charles H. McCann Medical Assistance program in 1962.

Mrs. Morey worked as a medical assistant for Doctors Karl Markin and John Buoni from 1963 until retiring in 1982.

She was a communicant of the Parish of Blessed John Paul, Adams, where she served as a lector and office assistant. She was a member of the St. Thomas Aquinas Rosary Sodality and the Catholic Daughters of the Americas. She was also a member of the Adams Post 160 American Legion Ladies Auxiliary and had served as the District Director in 1969. She enjoyed gardening, reading, sewing and cooking for her family.

Her husband, Russell F. Morey, whom she married on January 15, 1939, died on December 5, 2005.
