



Mr. LeRoy D. Schaffrick

April 10, 1942 - March 16, 2018

Mr. LeRoy Damon Schaffrick, 75, of Cheshire, died on Friday, March 16, 2018 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Derby, CT on April 10, 1942, a son of the late Emil and Doris (Bragdon) Schaffrick. He attended schools in Adams and Cheshire and graduated from the former Adams High School.

Mr. Schaffrick last worked as a heavy equipment mechanic and operator for several construction companies until he retired. Leroy also enjoyed his volunteer work with the American Legion VFW #144.

He joined the Berkshire Lodge of Freemasons in Adams in September of 1999 which started his long and proud affiliation with the Upton Lodge in Cheshire and the New Moon Lodge in Pittsfield. Leroy was also a proud member of the Melha Shrine in Springfield, Berkshire Shrine Club and the Scottish Rite of Western MA

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, the former Rose E. Malloy, whom he married on June 16, 1962;
