



## Edward Dunaj

Mr. Edward Peter Dunaj, 84, of 31 Bradford St. Pittsfield, died early Sunday morning at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on February 25, 1920, a son of the late Peter and Mary (Stojda) Dunaj, and attended Adams schools.

He was a veteran of World War II, serving with the 7801st Station Complement Unit of the US Army in the European Theater, until his Honorable Discharge as a First Lieutenant in 1948.

Following his discharge, Mr. Dunaj lived for a time in New York City, and then in the Albany, New York area, where he was self employed as a real estate broker, until retiring and returning to Pittsfield in 1992.

While in Adams, he was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church.

He is survived by 2 nieces - Beverly Bissell of Lee, MA and Carol Lattizzori of Pittsfield, MA; and by 2 nephews - Dr. Ronald Gintowt and Charles Gintowt, both of Westfield, MA; and several grandnieces & grandnephews.

He was predeceased by 3 brothers - Stanley, Fred and John Dunaj, and by 5 Sisters - Charlotte Dunaj, Stacia Dunay, Helen Furtek, Antonina Ostrowski, and Anna Gintowt.

The funeral will be held on Wednesday, Nov. 24th, at 9:00 AM from the Auge`-Paciorek-Simmons Funeral Home, 13 Hoosac St. Adams, followed by a Liturgy of Christian Burial at 10:00 AM in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, celebrated by Rev.
