



Edward Krutiak

Mr. Edward Krutiak, 91, of 9 Overlook Terrace, Adams, died early Thursday morning, July 31, 2014, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on December 2, 1922, a son of the late Theodore and Helena (Rogowa) Krutiak, and attended schools in Savoy.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the Army Air Corps in Hawaii, until his Honorable Discharge in 1946.

Mr. Krutiak owned and operated the former Krutiak Wood Products Co. in Clarksburg for over 50 years, until selling the business in 2004.

He had been a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II at Notre Dame des Sept Douleurs Church, Adams. He was a member of Adams Post 160 American Legion.

He enjoyed the outdoors, and especially enjoyed growing and harvesting his own Christmas Trees.

He is survived by his wife of 71 years, the former Dorothy L. Lagoy, whom he married on August 27, 1943;
