



## Edward T. Ramocki

May 19, 1932 - February 24, 2010

Mr. Edward Thomas Ramocki, 77, of 93 Wealthy Ave. Pittsfield, died early Wednesday morning, Feb. 24, 2010, at his home.

He was born in Adams on May 19, 1932, a son of the late Stanley and Stefania (Kmiec) Ramocki. He graduated from St. Stanislaus Kostka Elementary School and from the former Adams High School in 1950. He also graduated from several General Electric Apprentice Programs. He had lived in Pittsfield since 1955.

He was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving with the US Navy.

Mr. Ramocki worked as a technician in the High Voltage Laboratory of General Electric Co. in Pittsfield, retiring in 1992 after 40 years of service.

He was a communicant of Sacred Heart Church in Pittsfield, and while in Adams, was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church. He was a member of the Pittsfield Sportsman's Club and the General Electric Quarter Century and Pensioner's Clubs. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, and was fond of his Beagle hunting dogs. He enjoyed trips to the Foxwood casino, the Boston Red Sox and especially enjoyed spending time with his family.

He is survived by his wife of 55 years, the former Elaine H. Sweet, whom he married on June 4, 1955;

4 Grandchildren, Stephen and David Wehry; and Matthew and Rachel Arseneau; and several nieces & nephews.

He was predeceased by a daughter, Laurie Ann Ramocki, in 1956; and by 2 brothers, Chester and Stanley Ramocki.
